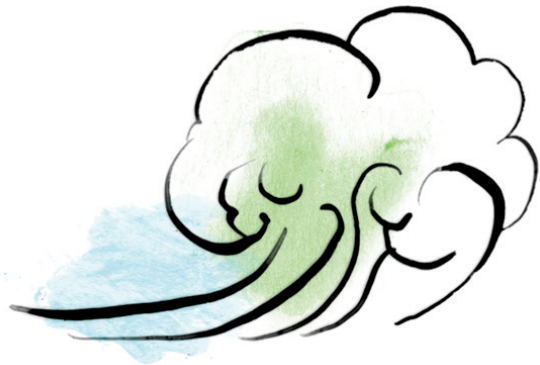
Underneath a starry solitude
